Welcome

The Friends of the Stockton & Darlington Railway (S&DR) together with the relevant local branches of the Campaign for Real Ale (Cleveland, Darlington and Durham) invite you to ride along the route of the historic railway (and beyond) by train, sampling real ales in some of our fine bars, clubs and other outlets.

The S&DR opened on 27 September 1825, hence 2025 sees bi-centenary celebrations along the line. The original idea for the line was to transfer coal from the land-locked collieries in South Durham to the nearest navigable water – the Port at Stockton – for export to London, but it was soon realised that the movement of other goods – and passengers – could be equally viable.

The line was quickly extended in all directions, giving us a railway network which includes today's Network Rail line from Bishop Auckland to Saltburn (which includes most of the original S&DR) with passenger services provided by Northern Rail.

Based in the Canteen Bar & Kitchen, which itself is based in the former Shildon Works Canteen, bar and brewery sharing the same room. Kitchen open from breakfast but no alcohol served until mid-day.

Multi-CAMRA award winning family-run club near several S&DR-related heritage sites in the Northgate / North Road area. Has a separate lounge away from the snooker tables. Four rotating guest beers from micros, and two beer festivals every year. Tucked away down a side alley off the famous High Street, multi-CAMRA award winning micropub (Stockton's first) serving five ever-changing real ales alongside an impressive range of craft beers, ciders and bottled beers. Organises several community-focussed and charity events.
